Collecting Memories for posterity

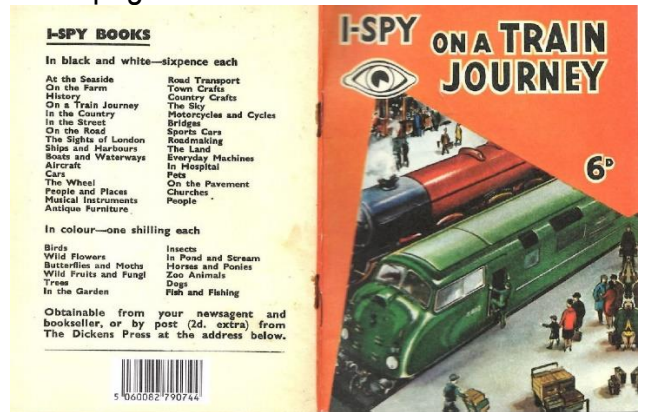
